Beat the Street is being delivered by Active Cornwall as part of **Let's Go**, a new local campaign that we're trialling in partnership. **Let's Go** is all about helping communities shape what this social movement looks like and deciding what activities and ideas matter most to them.

Last week, your child brought home a Beat the Street card for themselves and for you as well as a physical map of where the Beat boxes are located around the town.

When you receive your card, it's really important that you complete the short survey. Not only will this give you a chance to be entered into a prize draw, but it also helps us better understand the area and apply for additional funding in Penzance. This funding could go towards projects like skate parks, improved green spaces, or whatever the community feels is most needed.
