This weeks, Headteacher award was awarded to our amazing Year 6 Class this week. You all tried your absolute best in your SATs and we are all so very proud of you. Well done!



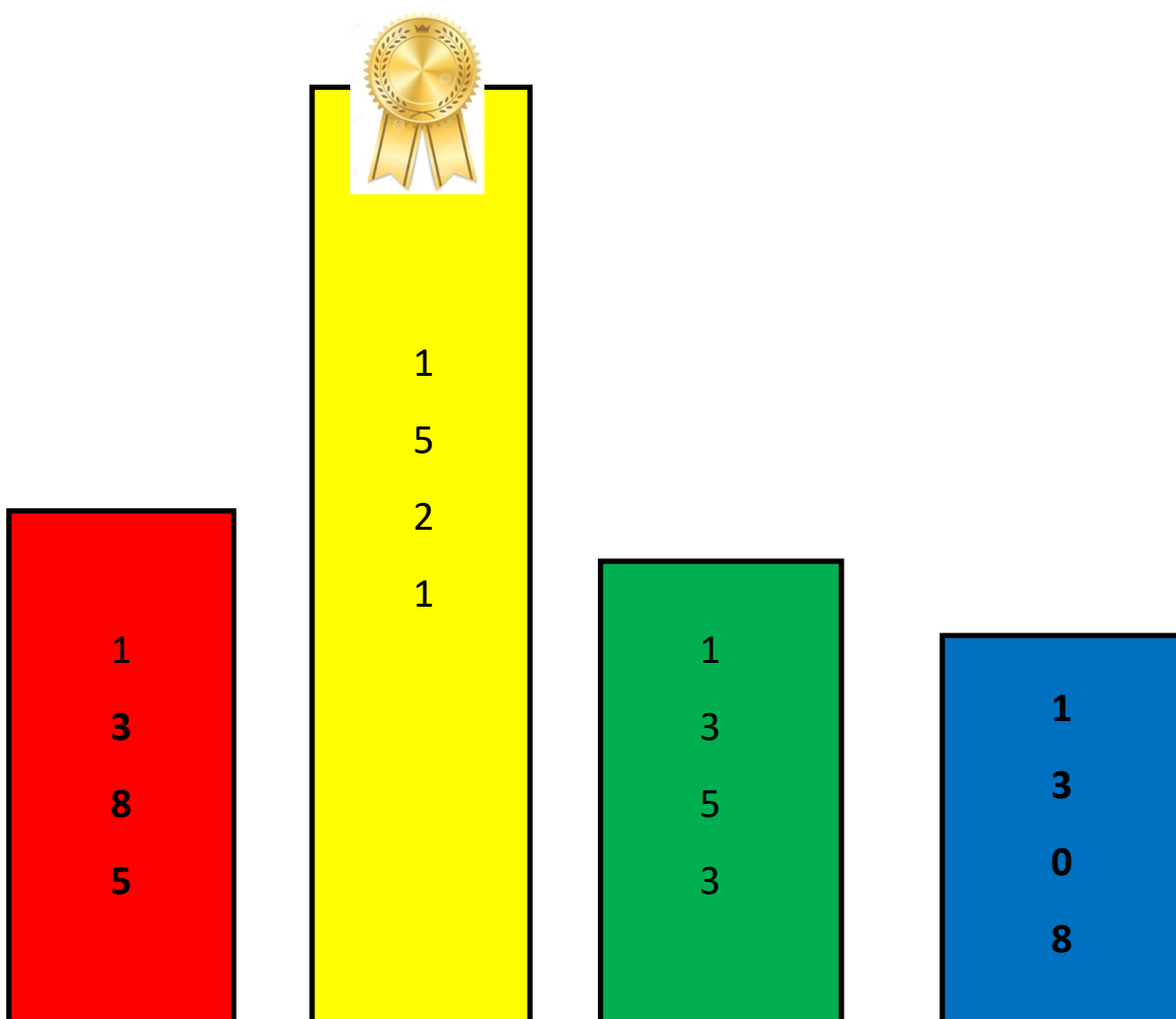

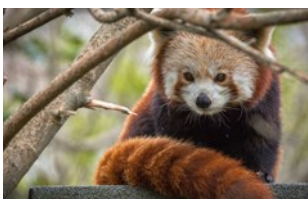


Save The Date
